The Houston Methodist Administrative Fellowship Program lasts a total of 18 months. The first month is spent meeting with senior leadership throughout the organization and learning about key initiatives. Following the orientation period, individuals enter into a rotation-based curriculum with some customization available to optimize the fellow's experience.
